- 4.5.1. Status Update on EMFAC2021 in Response to California's Clean Air Act's Waivers Revocation Nesamani Kalandiyur, CARB, reported the following:
 - CARB staff continued developing adjustment factors for EMFAC2021 in response to federal rescission of two of the state's Clean Air Act waivers, namely the Heavy-Duty Engine and Vehicle Omnibus Low NOx and Advanced Clean Trucks (ACT) regulations. CARB staff expected to submit the adjustment factors to U.S. EPA for approval in November 2025.
 - CARB staff also announced the biannual joint CARB/CTC/HCD meeting scheduled for November 6, 2025 in Sacramento. This meeting would focus on the Clean Air Act waivers revocation issue including conformity lockdown and would be a good opportunity for stakeholders to provide public comments.
